




NOTICE OF EXPIRATION OF CRITICAL PERIOD MANAGEMENT FOR THE SAN ANTONIO POOL OF THE EDWARDS AQUIFER

The purpose of this notice is to advise Edwards Aquifer (Aquifer) groundwater withdrawal permit holders that the General Manager of the Edwards Aquifer Authority (EAA) has determined that applicable triggers for Stage I of the EAA Critical Period Management Plan no longer exist for the San Antonio Pool of the EAA jurisdictional area. The General Manager hereby gives notice of the expiration of Critical Period Management for the San Antonio Pool. For permit administration purposes, the transition out of Critical Period is effective November 9, 2015.

When water levels of the Aquifer or springflow at San Marcos or Comal springs decline below certain trigger levels, the Critical Period Management Plan for the San Antonio Pool is implemented to reduce withdrawals from the Aquifer. This plan is designed to slow the rate of decline of Aquifer levels or springflows.
