Please have your trash and recycle carts out no later than **7:00 a.m.** to receive service. Waste Management suggests that your cart be set 4-5 feet away from all objects and positioned with the handles/wheels facing your home. Please do not overfill carts or place items on top of the closed lid. If you need an additional recycle or trash cart, you may request one for an additional monthly fee.



Brush and bulk collection is limited to six (6) cubic yards combined and will occur once-a-month during the **second full week of the month. No piles should be at the curb until the Friday before the service week.**

Please have your bulk/brush items out by 7:00 a.m. to ensure pick up. Residents will also have UNLIMITED access to At Your Door Special Collection. This service provides residents with front-porch service to collect the difficult, sometimes hazardous, and hard-to-recycle items that almost every household accumulates, such as paint, pesticides, electronic waste, and batteries. The phased approach to reopening the library focuses on the vast amount of considerations that are needed to ensure that the library environment is both physically and psychologically safe for staff and patrons. Library will be open Mon-Wed and Fri from 10am-5pm also on Thurs 11-6

**Only 15 patrons will be allowed in the library at a time*

- Patrons must wear a mask at all times, with a thirty-minute time limit
- Staff will take patrons' temperature using a non-contact digital infrared forehead thermometer
- Patrons may only browse books, audios, and DVDs on the shelves
- No loitering or computer usage will be permitted
- Restrooms will be closed to the public
- All children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult at all times
