Applications for the positions of District 1, District 2, and Mayor will be accepted beginning January 13th through 5 p.m. February 12th, 2021, for the 2021 General Election.

Be sure and check your voter's registration card to ensure your information is correct before the upcoming 2021 General Election. If you have not received a new card this year, please contact the Elections Office at 830-741-6104.

If you have not registered or need to transfer from a different precinct, not in the same county and territory, you have until April 1st. Voter Registration applications are available at our Public Library, 802 London, the Medina County Elections Office, 1202 14th Street Hondo, or you may go on-line to www.votetexas.gov and print an application to submit to the Medina County Elections Office. To be eligible to vote in the May 1st General Election you must submit your application by April



Be a Good Neighbor, Follow the Code

Junk and Abandoned Cars

An abandoned motor vehicle means a motor vehicle that:

1. Is inoperable, is more than five years old, and has been left unattended for more than 48 hours;
2. Has remained on private property without the consent of the owner or person in charge of the property for more than 48 hours; or
3. Has been left unattended on the right-of-way of a designated county, state, or federal highway for more than 48 hours.

A junked vehicle means a self-propelled vehicle and:

1. Does not have lawfully attached unexpired license plate or valid motor vehicle inspection certificate;
2. Is wrecked, dismantled or partially dismantled, or discarded; or
3. Is inoperable and has remained inoperable for more than:
 - 72 consecutive hours, if the vehicle is on public property
 - 30 consecutive days if the vehicle is on private property.

The Castroville Police Department may remove, preserve, and/or store abandoned/junk vehicles that violate the City Code.
