- Continuous Garage/ Yard Sales (CZO Art. IV, Sec. 10)
- Parking on Unapproved Surfaces (CZO Art. V, Sec. 2)

8 a.m. to 6 p.m. **OR until the dumpster is full**

Waste Management will provide a dumpster at the park, located at the parking lot closest to the amphitheater, for any excess items you may want to dispose of.

The General Election for the positions of District 1 and Mayor is almost upon us.

Early voting dates and times are:

Monday, April 19, Tuesday, April 20, Thursday, April 22,

Friday, April 23, 2021, will be from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Wednesday, April 21, and Tuesday, April 27, 2021, will be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Saturday, April 24, 2021, early voting will be from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Saturday, May 1, 2021, Election Day will be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

The main Polling location for the upcoming joint General and School Elections will be at the Medina County Annex Building, Precinct 2, located at 8366 FM 471 South, Castroville, Texas.

Citizens of Castroville have the option to vote at any of the polling places located within Medina County. Please check the Medina County Elections website for the additional designated polling locations.
