CITY COUNCIL INITIATES ‘CASTROVILLE CARES’ -UTILITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Concurrent with the utility rate adjustments made by the Council in October of 2021, the Castroville City Council directed staff to establish a utility assistance program. City staff worked with representatives from the Community Council of South Central Texas (CCSCT), which provides similar services for Medina Electric, Reliant, and several other cities, to create the “Castroville Cares Program.” This program will offer qualifying families financial assistance to help pay their utility bills. The Council has allocated up to \$20,000 for this program for the remainder of the year.

No watering on weekends with a sprinkler or irrigation system.

The Edwards Aquifer Authority implemented Stage 1 Water restrictions effective March 10, 2022. Stage 1 is now mandatory for all of Castroville as per the recently approved amendment to our Drought Contingency Ordinance.

Please ensure you follow the watering schedule for your address. The EAA requires Edwards aquifer groundwater permit holders in Atascosa, Bexar, Caldwell, Comal, Guadalupe, Hays, and Medina counties to reduce their annual authorized pumping amount by 20 percent during Stage 1. The purpose of mandatory pumping reductions is to stabilize water levels and spring flow until rainfall replenishes the aquifer.
