STAGE 2 WATER RESTRICTIONS

The Edwards Aquifer Authority implemented Stage 2 Water restrictions effective April 11, 2022. Stage 2 is mandatory for all of Castroville as per the recently approved amendment to our Drought Contingency Ordinance.

Despite recent rains, we are still in Stage 2 of the City's Watering Rules. Please remember to use your sprinkler system only on the designated days based on the last digit of your address to ensure you follow the watering schedule. You may water with a hand-held hose at any time on any day. If you have questions about the effort to reduce water usage by 30%, please call Public Works at 830-931-4090. Landscape watering with an irrigation system or sprinkler is allowed once a week only between the hours of 7 a.m. - 11 a.m. and 7 p.m. - 11 p.m. on your designated watering day as determined by your address:

WATERING SCHEDULE



Watering day determined by last digit of address.

No watering on weekends with a sprinkler or irrigation system.



Bulk Waste Pickup

Please do not place bulk items or brush near meters, fences, mailboxes, or trees, underneath utility wires, or in front of parked cars. VACANT lots will NOT be serviced! Pick-up is limited to one collection per residence and will occur once a month during the second full week, with the collection starting on Monday for the entire city. Once the truck has passed your residence, it will not come back through. Therefore, make sure to have your waste out the weekend before the 2nd Monday of every month. Tree limbs must be cut down to 4 ft in length. Small limbs must be bundled and should not exceed 50 lbs. Remember total combined bulk and brush must not exceed 6 cubic yds. Residents also have access to At Your Door Special Collection, which provides residents with front-porch service to collect difficult, sometimes hazardous, and hard-to-recycle items. As part of our vegetation management program, we have scheduled right-of-way work in the City of Castroville



Cedar Beetle will be performing the work, as contractors, all Cedar Beetle employees will have credentials showing they are working for the City. The work will primarily be along public access roads and overhead power lines, but they may need to enter some private properties to complete the vegetation work.

Maintaining an appropriate clearance around power lines is important for safety and preventing outages. Our vegetation management program is managed by a certified arborist
