PARKS AND REC MASTER PLAN UPDATE

Our Parks Master Plan started when the Friends of Castroville Regional Park applied for a Community Grant through Microsoft Spring 2020 for a Parks Master Plan. Microsoft awarded \$21,000 to FCRP for the Parks and Recreation Master Plan Early Summer 2020. FCRP contracted Vista Planning & Design in early August 2020 to start Master Plan design. Due to Covid-19, pandemic, causing delays to public engagement and overall project. Vista Planning and Design presented a draft document in early October 2021.



We are proud to announce that we finally have a Parks Master Plan! We still have some minor edits to complete and are pending approval by our City Council. Once approved, we will be starting multiple projects during the year 2022.

Castroville Parks and Recreation would like to give special thanks to everyone involved in helping our Friends of Castroville Regional Park, Parks Board, and Steering Committee through this long process.
