## NEW PAYMENT KIOSK AT THE LIBRARY WILL HELP MAKE BILL PAY EASIER AND MORE CONVENIENT



The City of Castroville is constantly looking for ways to better serve our customers; as part of this effort, we are excited to announce a new payment kiosk at the Castroville Library. Beginning in September, the new bill pay kiosk will be open 24 hours a day, seven days a week and will be accessible via the new drive. It is similar to a bank ATM - it has an easy-to-use touch screen and bill scanner and will accept both cash, checks and credit cards. The kiosk will process Castroville utility bills as well as court fines. Customer service will also be available 24/7 via a 1-800 number that is displayed prominently on the kiosk. Our friendly librarians are also available to assist anyone who has questions or concerns. We sincerely hope our businesses and residents will enjoy using this new fast and convenient payment kiosk.

### CITY OF CASTROVILLE 2022-23 BULK & BRUSH COLLECTION SCHEDULE

#### BULK

Bulk collection will be at the curb beginning the second full week of odd number months. Bulk collection is limited to six cubic yards. Please do not place bulk items near meters, fences, or trees.

ACCEPTED: carpeting (cut into 4-foot bundles); household furniture; appliances only if CFCS are re-moved; and broken down and bundled cardboard boxes not placed in the recycle cart.

NOT ACCEPTED: appliances containing CFCs; concrete, brick, and roofing; construction debris from a contractor; items heavier than 200 pounds; and motor oil, filter, vehicles, tires, and parts.

#### BRUSH

Brush collection will be at the curb beginning the second full week of even number months. Brush bundles should not exceed four (4) feet in length, six (6) inch in diameter, or 50 pounds. Neatly stacked and tied bundles are preferred but not required.



#### BULK & BRUSH CALENDAR

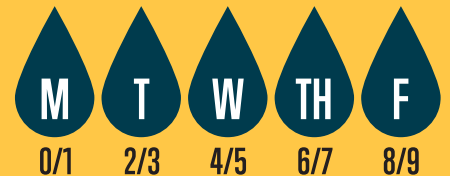
Collection service will not occur on the following holidays: Thanksgiving, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.
