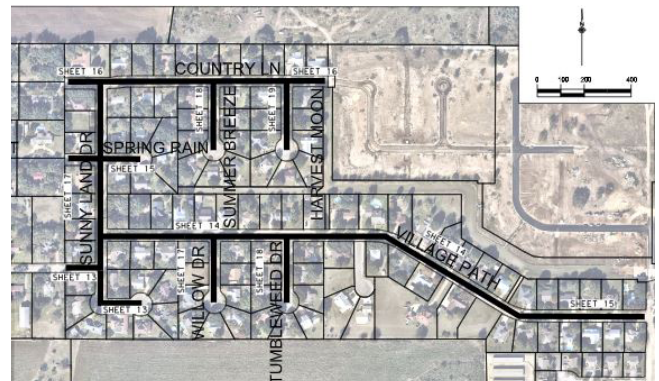

Country Village Street Project

This project is a Mill and Overlay Project, where the contractor is removing the first two inches of asphalt and re-installing a new driving surface. Where feasible, the contractor is repairing localized pavement failures and utility trench failures that create the ponding or pavement birdbaths.

In addition, the contractor will help alleviate some of the water ponding and drainage issues along the curb gutter line by leveling up these areas to promote positive drainage flow. The intent is not to fix all drainage concerns but to help guide water to its designated drainage outfall. Currently, the contractor has completed all roadway improvements. Our next step is evaluating the areas requiring level-up and curb replacement and working on returning drainage inlets to the initial design—roadway project completion is estimated within the next few weeks. Drainage improvements to channel inlets will be completed internally by city Streets and Drainage crew under the supervision of the City Engineer.

New Pool Heating Units Installed

Last year in September, the City Council approved the purchase of Pool Heater's for the Castroville City Pool. Parks and Streets Director Devin Fredrickson jumped right on the project and issued purchase orders and began working with CPS to ensure the projects completion.

The city began pouring the concrete pads for the project on October 4 and had the heaters installed by October 5. The team of city employees met to plan construction of the gas line and had the new gas lines finished by November 2.

The pool heaters were inspected on November 7 and the heaters were on-line by November 9. A host of city employees jumped in to make sure this project ran smoothly and was completed in a timely fashion.

Since the pool heater completion, the pool has been used frequently by the pool fitness class, dive team, and the MVISD swim team.
