CURBSIDE MANNERS

Pick up occurs **once-a-month** beginning the **second full week** of the month.

Type of collection is determined by month, see below.

Please do not put items out until the Friday before pickup begins for each month.

Collection service will **NOT** occur on the following holidays: Thanksgiving, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.



BULK COLLECTION MONTHS:

(Odd months)

January, March, May, July, September and November

BRUSH COLLECTION MONTHS:

(Even months)

February, April, June, August, October and December.

Please do not place bulk items or brush near meters, fences, mailboxes, or trees, underneath utility wires, or in front of parked cars. VACANT lots will NOT be serviced! Once the truck has passed your residence, it will not come back through. Tree limbs must be cut down to 4 ft in length. Small limbs must be bundled and should not exceed 50 lbs. Remember total bulk or brush must not exceed 6 cubic yds. Thank you for doing your part to keep Castroville beautiful! For further assistance or questions, please call 830-931-0033.

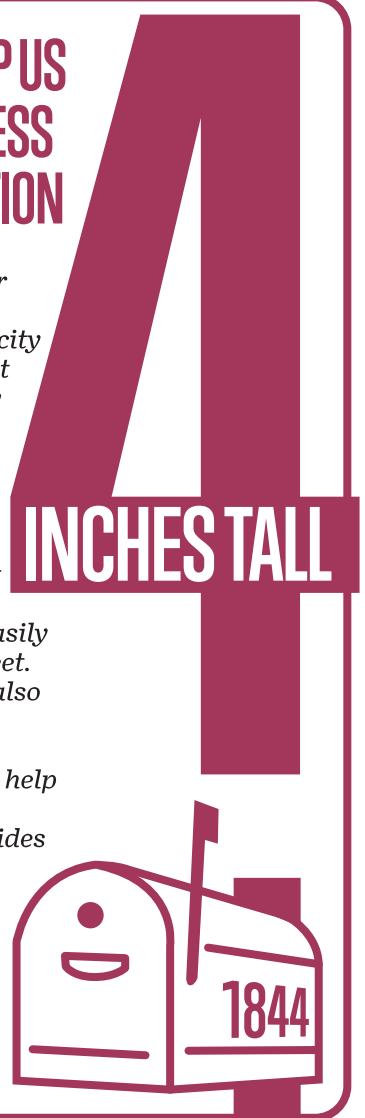
