## PREFACE

This file is the product of a tape-recorded interview conducted by the Castroville Public Library Oral History Project B. The interview was taped on September 26, 1980 by Faustina Sharp. The interview took place in the home of the narrator in Castroville, Texas.

Cornelia Mangold's parents were Henry Wurzbach and Fannie Schuchart. She was born September 17, 1896. She grew up about nine miles northeast of Castroville. Her family had a Sunday house in Castroville. Cornelia came to Castroville for three years of school with the Sisters of Divine Providence. She married Alfred Mangold of LaCoste, and they raised their family in the same rural area she grew up. In this interview, Cornelia talks about her family life and early social customs.
