NEW METER, NEW BILLING PERIOD.



The new billing date for all installed smart meters is the 28th of each month. The billing period will start on the 29th of the previous month and ends on the 28th of the current billing month. BUT, this month your bill will still reflect your old billing date. The billing system will be updated to reflect the new billing date beginning with the October 10 utility bill.

The billing period for this month, began on July 29 and ended on August 28, resulting in a 30-day billing period.

All payments are due on the 25th of each month. While the contractor completes installation, we will still manually read some meters.

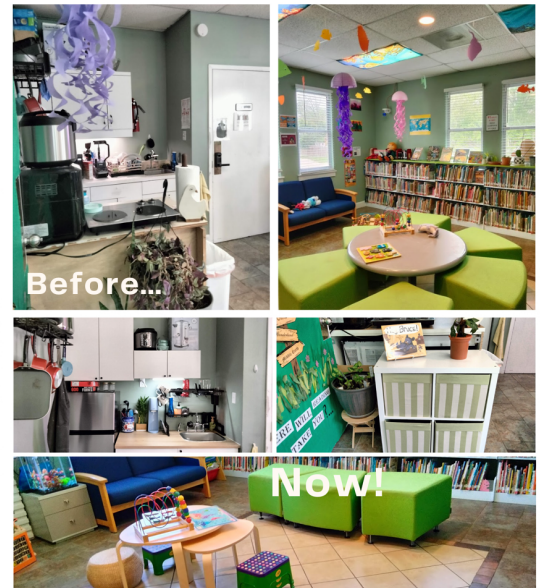
