## PREFACE

This file is the product of a tape-recorded interview conducted by the Castroville Public Library Oral History Project B. The interview was conducted by Connie Rihn at the Library on September 26, 1980.

Stanley Haby was born on March 6, 1910 in Dunlay, Texas. His parents were Edmund Haby and Scholastical Hutzler, both of Alsatian descent. Stanley married Ella Bippert and after a few years decided to move from the family farm to Castroville to learn the baker trade from Mr. John Grice. He bought the business and operated Haby's Bakery in Castroville from 1940 until 1975, when he retired. Since his retirement, he keeps busy with his many hobbies-ranching, gardening, wine-making, and he has built several windmills.

In this interview Stanley talks about the bakery business, how they worked in the early days, and how he learned to make the french bread which has become famous in Castroville.
