RATE INCREASE SCHEDULED FOR FEBRUARY 10

Increasing electric, gas, sewer, and water rates in Castroville is crucial for the health of our community. These essential services are the backbone of a functioning and sustainable city. We have held off on this adjustment until we had no other choice. These rates allow us to keep up with the costs of inflation that we are currently experiencing. This adjustment will also enable us to invest to ensure a reliable and efficient supply of electricity, gas, clean water, and proper sewage treatment. This investment is vital for public health, as it helps prevent disruptions in service, reduce the risk of contamination, and maintain the overall well-being of our residents.

The Castroville City Council approved water, sewer, gas and electric rate increases on November 14, 2023. The new rates became effective on January 01, 2024. These new rates will be on your utility bill for February 10, 2024.
