







# CPL SUMMER PROGRAMS



Magic The Gathering Build Your Own Deck night was held on June 1, where participants came to build their standard decks of cards to keep and enjoy. The supplies for the event were provided free by MagiKids, a non-profit organization that seeks to encourage creativity and growth through building decks and playing Magic The Gathering. Both new and experienced players learned from our library assistants how to read the actual cards (including the five major colors to know), and were also provided sleeves for their cards for added protection and how to set up their battlefield for victory. After the participants finished making their decks, they got to put them to use by battling one another with library staff close by if they needed any tips. Magic The Gathering games are hosted at the library every week on Thursday nights.

Film Club consists of patrons watching and discussing a film every Monday. Patrons viewed five movies in the horror genre before our last showing on July 17. The open discussions about the film were then consolidated into a review for each film discussed, and the reviews were then shared on the library's social media platform. The club voted on what points to be used in the review and what rating system, if any, would be used. Near the end of the program, the club decided to not use the star rating system since most films they watched were rated five stars. While the film club has ended, it may resume later this fall for Halloween, depending on participation.



The San Antonio Food Bank program at the Castroville Public Library allows us to offer free healthy and accessible meals to any and all children under the age of 18 who enter our library. Every day, 30 freshly made lunches and snacks are delivered to our library to provide for the children in our community. The program has been running since June 1st and will end on August 11th.





## TOTAL MATERIAL CIRCULATIONS




















