

## TOTAL MATERIAL CIRCULATIONS









# PRESERVING OUR HISTORY

The Castroville Public Library Oral History Project is being transformed from analog to digital format. Digitization involves converting the cassette tapes into digital formats that are easier to archive, search, and share for researchers, historians, and the public for efficient use on the Castroville Public Library Webpage. The St. Louis Church Archives project is 100% complete, and approximately half of the Oral History Project B has been digitized. All of the Oral History Project transcripts are scanned and uploaded. The Oral History Project was originally conducted by the Castroville Public Library, which means we own any copyright and have full rights to digitize these items and make them freely available to the public. We will continue our efforts to digitize the remaining portion of the oral history collection with a set date to go live on the website at the end of September. (Staff member William is heading up this project)



UNT has begun to upload the local newspapers! Here is the link to the Castroville Public Library partner page: <https://texashistory.unt.edu/explore/partners/CVPL> The Library staff has sent a paragraph describing how the newspapers have supported the history and people of Castroville using the TexTreasures grant application. That UNT staff will provide a link with the exact page count of what has been uploaded thus far. Library staff will send a final report at the end of September to TSLAC with the most current page count numbers downloaded and the overall grant report. UNT has yet to determine this project's end time, but we look forward to all updates from Ana Krahmer, the Director of the Digital Newspaper Program. Currently, the Library has over 2,577 historical documents archived.



## Castroville Public Library



**Castroville Public Library History**

The Castroville Public Library was established in 1963 by members of the Home Demonstration Club. The founding members (Kay Tschirhart, Susie Kempf, Yvonne Tschirhart, and Helen Ann Boehme) founded the library with donated books in a room located at City Hall that is now used as City Council chambers. This group enlisted the late Helen C. Murrell to be the first librarian, and she held this position for ten years. The library remained at City Hall until 1980 when it was apparent that more space was needed for this facility. In 1980, the Castroville Public Library moved to 802 London Street, which is the current location.




# SUMMER OF FUN AT THE LIBRARY







## COMPUTER LOGIN AVERAGES YEAR TO DATE TOTAL 2,213








