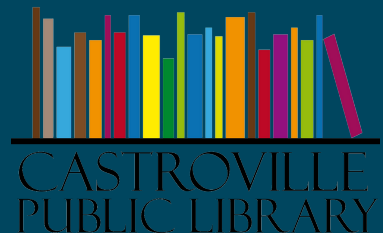

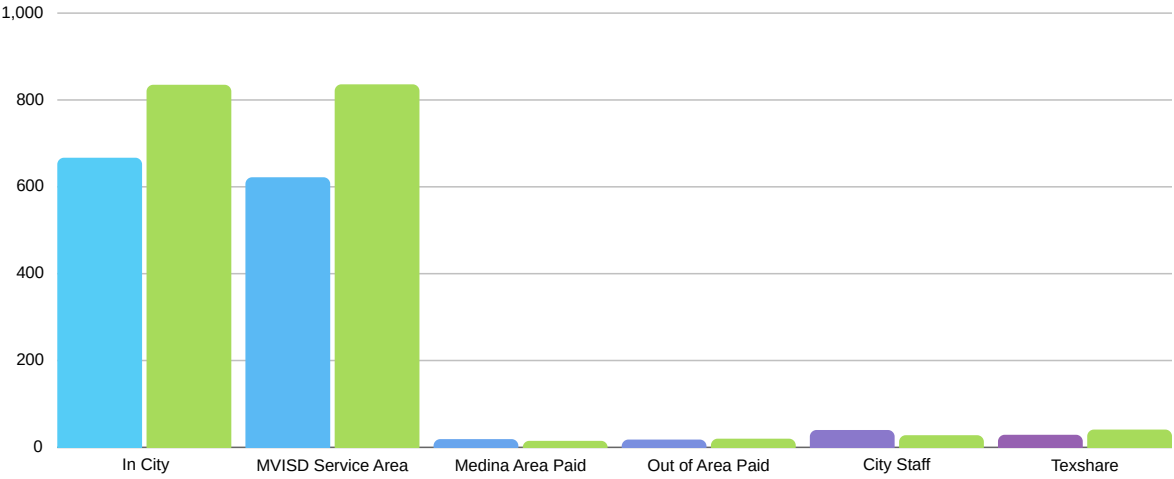

MEMBER STATISTICS: ACTIVE ACCOUNTS

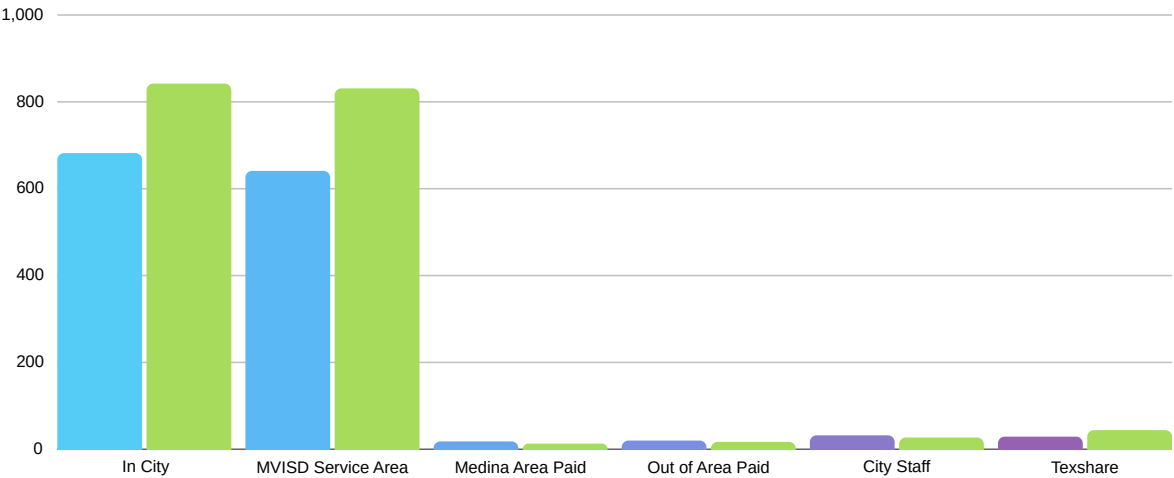

GEARING UP FOR GIVING

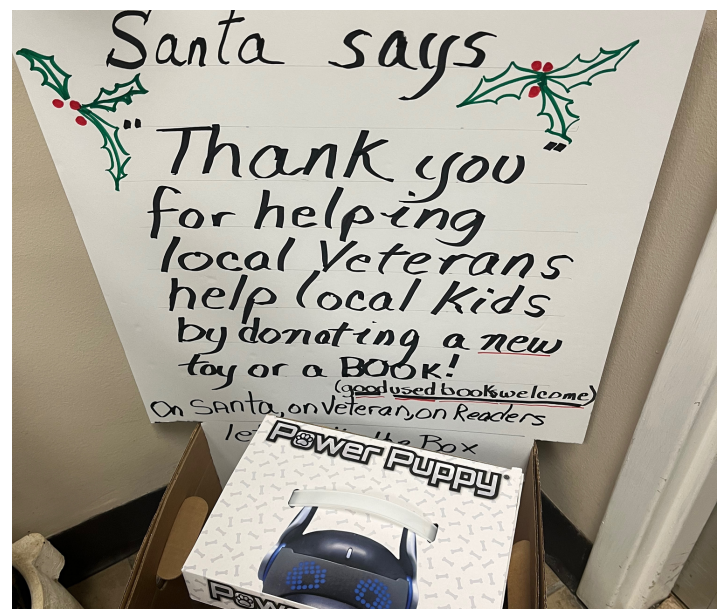
HANKS KIDS

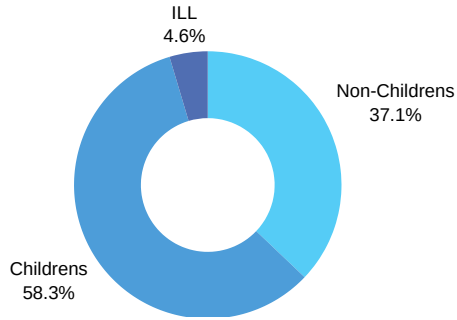
AMERICAN LEGION POST 460

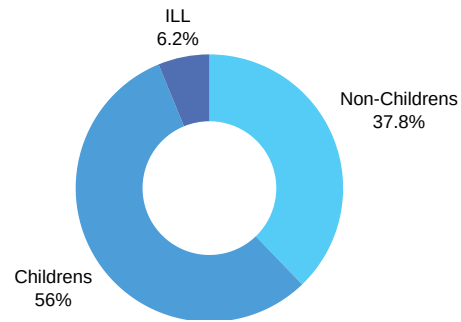
CIRCULATION STATISTICS TYPE

TOTAL MATERIAL CIRCULATIONS



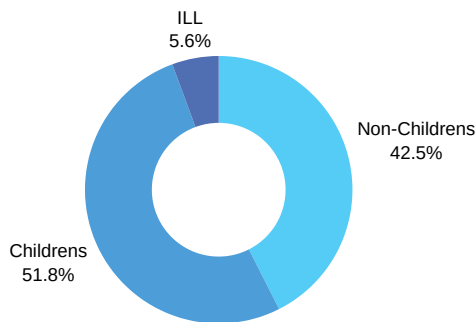

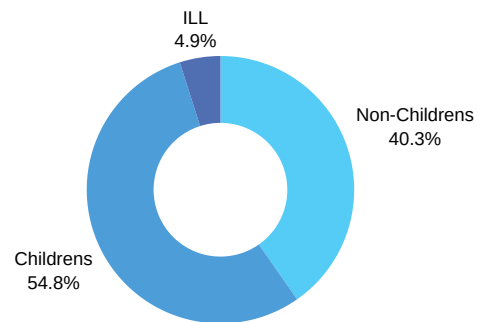

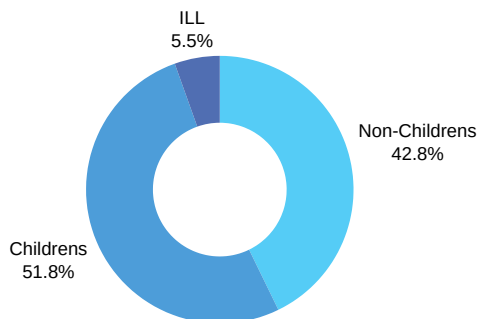

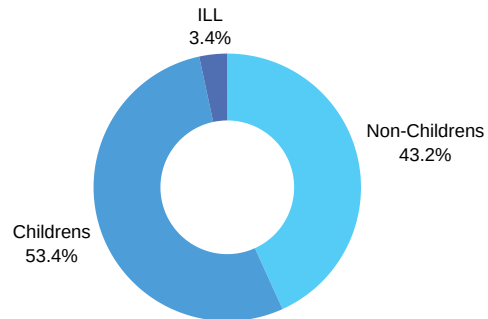

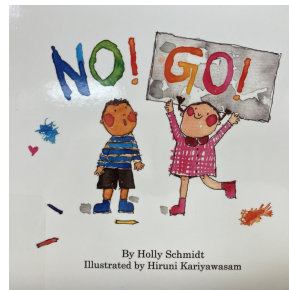
GREAT ROOM ESCAPE TEAM-BUILDING

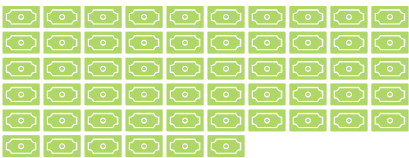

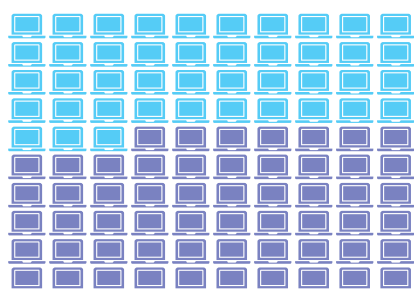

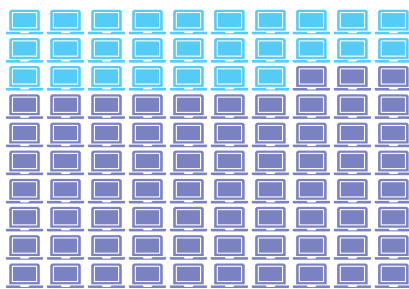

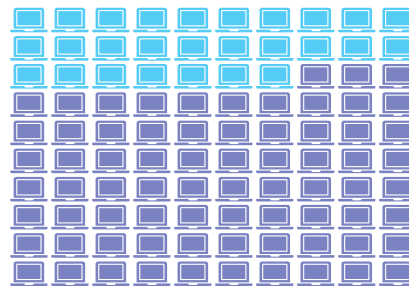

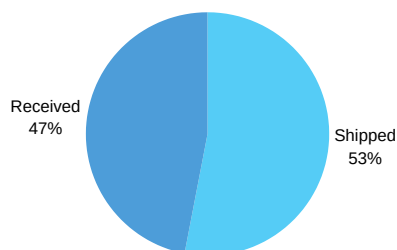

COMPUTER LOGIN AVERAGES YEAR TO DATE TOTAL 708

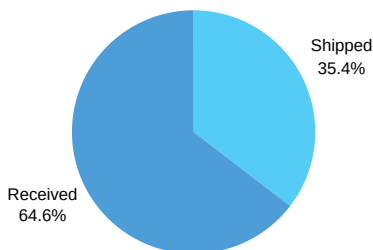

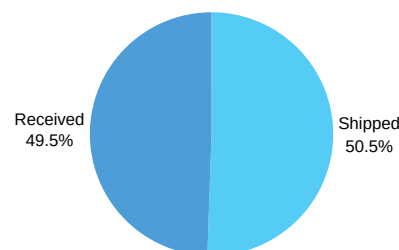

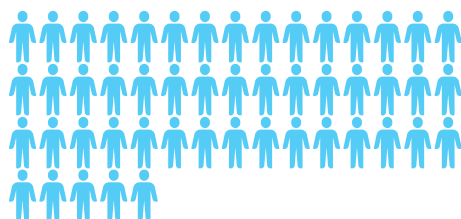

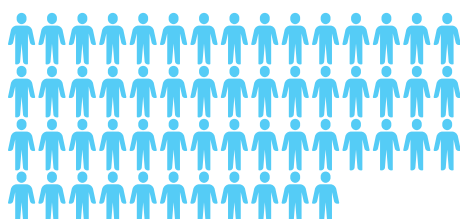

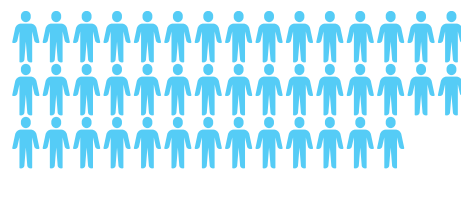
