MASTER PLANNING AND UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE PROCESS CONTINUES.

77 People gave feedback during this second round of discussions.

On March 27-28, the Design Rodeo phase of the Castroville Building Block Project began, with 77 people giving initial feedback.

Attendees of the March design rodeo gave feedback on:

An analysis of areas within Castroville city limits and surrounding it, categorizing areas into four types, such as Areas of Stability or Areas of Change.

Images of different types of buildings and whether they fit in various types of areas.

Which investments the City of Castroville should prioritize.

More discussion of a proposed idea to make crossing Hwy 90 safer.

A look at Paris Street as the Main Street of Castroville and how incremental improvements could enhance downtown.

What might be a good fit for potential redevelop of the current Public Works yard if the current use were relocated, and four land use sketches to spark conversation.

The same same maps and surveys will be posted online by Saturday April 13th, to give the rest of the public time to digest and give additional feedback through the end of May.

The final phase of the project will begin August 6-8th, 2024 with the Code Rodeo at the Braden-Keller Center.
