

LIONS PARK HAS NEW LIGHTS

Lions Park in Castroville has seen significant upgrades recently, enhancing its appeal and functionality. In May 2023, new restrooms and a parking lot were completed, providing convenience for visitors. The multi-purpose soccer fields were also updated in May 2023, with the addition of new lights slated for July 2024, extending playtime into the evenings. The park celebrated the grand opening of a new splash pad on June 10th, 2023, offering a fun and refreshing activity for children. Additionally, several new trees have been planted, thanks to a March 2023 Eagle Project and an April 2023 Microsoft grant, with more trees expected in the fall of 2024 as part of the Regional project.



Scout Bridge Renewal

In 2024, nearly 30 years after the original Scout Bridge was constructed by Eagle Scout Candidate, Michael Ortiz, another Eagle Scout Candidate, E.J. Arroyo, of Troop 471, dismantled the aging structure and completely reconstructed it. He used a modification of the original blueprint to improve durability. Funds and/or materials for the restoration were generously donated by the Friends of the Castroville Regional Park, Parker Lumber Company of Devine, South Texas Hardware, and Landscape Solutions of Castroville, as well as Dr. and Mrs. Bill Burges and Lee Delavan, Aircraft Consultants, Inc.

Replacing the Scout Pavilion
