WARRANT ROUND UP NOTIFICATION

On Saturday, April 16, 2016, members of the Castroville Police Department will be going to the homes and places of employment for those who have outstanding tickets with the City. If you are unsure if you have a warrant, please check the warrant list on the City's website at castrovilletx.gov/2209/Municipal-Court. If you have not made arrangements with the Castroville Municipal Court to take care of any tickets or warrants that you received in the City of Castroville, now is the time.

If you cannot pay your fine when caught, you could be taken to the Medina County Jail. **Please contact the Castroville Municipal Court at 830 931-4070, to make arrangements**, otherwise, expect to see Officers at your door.

BRUSH PILE GUIDELINES

- ⇒ Brush pickup is the 2nd week of every month. Do not set out earlier than one week before scheduled pickup.
- ⇒ Please limit brush to eight (8) cubic yards. (See image)
- ⇒ Brush must be placed within eight (8) feet of your curb.
- ⇒ Bulk pick-up is in June and November. Do not place bulky items out during this collection.
- ⇒ Do not place under low-hanging tree limbs or wires, on top of water meters, in front of parked cars, near fences or mailboxes, or other obstructions.
- ⇒ Do not place materials on empty lots.
