


HISTORIC LANDMARK COMMISSION

SPECIAL CALL MEETING

Thursday , February 17, 2022 6:30 P.M.

1. Call to Order - 6:31 P.M.
2. Roll Call - Present- Priscilla Garrett, Jeff Gardner, Rick Baes, Cindy & Dan Maloney, Houston Marchman, and Kyle McVay.
3. Citizens Comments : Jerome Iltis spoke on the Historical significance of September Sq. and keeping it compatible with the Veterans Memorial. It should be kept intact.
4. Minutes were approved for December 7, 2021 with the addition of Kyle McVay to the Roll Call.
5. Discussion on compliance procedure for approved Certificate of Appropriateness if work is not completed accurately as approved. Ordinance NO. 2017-005 passed on November 29, 2016 . Exhibit A penalties were discussed and the consensus of the Landmark Commission is the \$500 a day fine per violation should be enforced. The Code Compliance Officer is responsible for the enforcement.
6. Discussion on guidelines for September Sq. Recent request for use of September Sq. acknowledged that the City had no guidelines for the use of September Sq. It was determined that guidelines needed to be in place to protect the Square. The American Legion has a draft resolution concerning the compatibility use of the Sq. Priscilla suggested a workshop with the American Legion, Chamber of Commerce, & Conservation Society. HLC should have some specific suggestions at their next meeting prior to the workshop.
