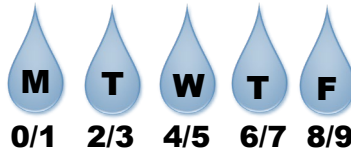




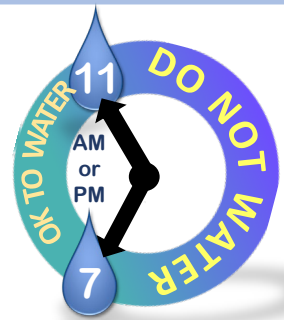

Watering Rules

WATERING SCHEDULE



Watering day determined by last digit of address



The City of Castroville uses drought restrictions, established by City Ordinance, to proactively manage the water resources.

Water use restrictions for demand reduction: Under threat of penalty for violation, the following water use restrictions shall apply to all persons:

- ◆ **All restrictions from Stage 1** remain in effect unless added to or replaced by Stage 2.
- ◆ **Landscape watering** with an irrigation system, sprinkler or soaker hose is allowed only once a week from 7-11 a.m. and 7-11 p.m. on your designated watering day, as determined by your address. **No watering on weekends with a sprinkler or irrigation system.**
- ◆ **Watering with a drip irrigation** is permitted any day, but only between 7-11 a.m. and 7-11 p.m.
- ◆ **Watering with a hand-held hose** or bucket is allowed any time on any day.
- ◆ **Use of grey water** is allowed at any time.
- ◆ **Hotels, motels and other lodging** must offer and clearly notify guests of a "linen/towel change on request only" program.
- ◆ **Use of water from hydrants** shall be limited to firefighting related activities, or other activities necessary to maintain public health, safety, and welfare, except that use of water from designated fire hydrants for construction purposes may be allowed under special permit from the city.
- ◆ **All restaurants** may prohibit the serving of water to patrons except upon request of the patron.

Target:

Achieve a 30 percent reduction total water usage.
